

Construction Site Waste Management Policy

Responsibilities:

Big Yellow Construction Company Limited and its contractors are responsible for the waste they produce during their site operations. It is their 'Duty of Care' to reduce the economic, environmental and social risks of their waste.

This policy commits to:

- Complying with waste legislation to reduce resource loss and pollution
- Reducing waste by protecting materials, working efficiently and using less
- Segregating hazardous waste on site and other wastes, space permitting
- Reusing and recycling waste on site if safe to do so
- Using authorised contractors, checking registration and keeping consignment notes

Hazardous Waste

Big Yellow commits to complying with the Hazardous Waste Directive and its contractors have full responsibility, under their 'Duty of Care' for the hazardous wastes they generate, store and dispose:

Dangerous



Toxic



Explosive



Irritant



Hazardous waste producers should register with the Environment Agency and hazardous waste should be:

- identified, quantified and separated
- treated where appropriate and stored in secure containers
- coded using European Waste Catalogue (EWC) codes on transfer notes
- provide separate containers for aerosol cans with warning signs
